

1. Whereas the Directorate had issued DGS Training Circular 08 of 2019 dated 30 / 04 / 2019 making it mandatory for candidates to possess passport prior undertaking any maritime course approved by the Directorate in a Maritime Training Institute (MTI) approved by the Directorate.
2. Whereas the Directorate had conducted workshops at Mumbai, Delhi, Chennai and Kolkata to familiarize the MTI's with the online systems and to address problems related to e-governance system prior to the issuance of the said Training Circular.
3. Whereas in order to facilitate admissions of candidates who do not possess passport, the issuance of INDoS number to such candidates was continued till 15 / 06 / 2019 as per para 14 of the said Training Circular.
4. Noting that the Directorate had received representations from MTIs' requesting for issuing INDoS number to candidates without being in possession of passport for some more time to facilitate admissions in pre-sea maritime training institutes.
5. In view of the above, the Director General of Shipping and Additional Secretary to Government of India has decided to extend the deadline for issuing INDoS number to candidates who do not possess passport. The para 14 of DGS Training Circular 08 of 2019 dated 30 / 04 / 2019 given as below
