### SHOW CAUSE NOTICE

1. It has been observed from the records of this Directorate that Chennai School of Ship Management is repeatedly violating the DGS guidelines with regard to the land requirement as per DGS Order No.2 of 2007. As per clause 2.3 of the said order -shifting of premises – the institute can conduct the courses at the new premises only after receiving the approval for new premises from DGS. The institute was operating from 1/156, School Street, Mambakkam Village, via Vandaloor, Kelambakkam Road, Kancheepuram Dist without obtaining this Directorate's permission.
2. Scheduled Inspection was carried out on 7.8.2013. Lease deed provided by the institute was unregistered one. The institute was instructed to comply with observations raised during this inspection. No compliance has been received till date.
3. Without Directorate's approval, the institute started operating from No.78, Merkandai Village, Vittilapuram (Post), Kalpakkam (via), Kanchipuram Dist. The institute was requested to submit the fresh application for shifting of premises with fee, registered lease deed and layout of premises vide letter dated 25.7.2014, however the same has not been done till date.
4. Thus the Institute has always remained defaulter on account of non-approval of shifting of premises and occupying the premises without registered lease deed. Further, the owner of the present premises i.e. CSC Trust has got an interim stay order which directs the Chennai School of Ship Management not to interfere in the peaceful occupation of the premises of CSC Trust and therefore the CSSM is now an illegal occupant of the premises.

5. In view of the above, the **major** non-conformity in respect of the Chennai School of Ship Management amounts to as under:

1. Shifting of premises without Directorate's approval and Non-compliance of land requirement.
2. Non-compliance of the observations raised during the audit dated 7.8.2013.


6. In addition to above, the following non-conformities have also been observed:

1. Non-payment of 1% annual fee on total fees from the year 2005-06.
2. Non-submission of batch details/placement details.

7. In view of above major non-conformity mentioned in para 5 and non-conformities mentioned in para 6, your institute is called upon to show cause as to why the suitable disciplinary action for non-conformity as per Part V of DGS Order No. 02 of 2007 should not be initiated against the institute.

8. This show cause notice is issued with the approval of the Director General of Shipping and ex-officio Additional Secretary to the Govt. of India, in exercise of powers conferred under Rule 75 of the Merchant Shipping (Standards of Training, Certification & Watch-keeping for Seafarers) Rules, 2014, notified under sec 78, 87, 88, 98, 456, 457 & 458 of MS Act, 1958.

9. The institute is further directed not to admit any student for any batch from the month of January, 2016.
