In reference to above mentioned subject, it is to inform you that 'STCW Compliance Board' is constituted under the chairmanship of Director General of Shipping, which will include the following members;


- i) Shri Kumar Sanjay Bariar, Addl. DG(S), Co-Chairman.

(a) All official members are free to depute any specific officer by proper authorisation to attend the meetings of the STCW board on a regular basis at the Co-Chairman level and meetings of the STCW board shall be held under rotating chairmanship for each of the Co-Chairman.

(b) The STCW compliance board shall meet at least one in three months and all such meetings shall be recorded and minuted with record thereof.


2. The terms of reference of the STCW Board shall be as follows;

- (i) To ensure the review of the Syllabus for training and standards of watch keeping as per the STCW mandate and the pedagogy, training dispensation methodology and aspects related to the training at MTIs and all aspects related to Faculty development, training and standardization.
- (ii) To review all functional aspects of the Competency and Proficiency assessment platform including the Central Attendance Software, the MTI Exit examination and the E- Learning platform and progressive improvement on the same.
- (iii) To periodically release the results for all MTIs, all examinations conducted for the CoC, CoP, Ratings as per norms and with due discretion and adherence to publication of results with comprehensive analysis of the results for MTI exit examinations, ratings and for the CoCs (Written and Oral).
- (iv) To act as the advisory board for all aspects related to the compliances to STCW.
- (v) To examine and advise on matters related to MTI functioning and compliance to STCW and DGS Circulars.
- (vi) The STCW compliance board shall review all engagements of D.G (Shipping) for examination/ assessment platform reform and other related matters thereof.
- (vii) To act as the advisory body to recommend and shortlist meritorious candidates for scholarships, training and exposure visits.

- (viii) To advise on all aspects in the training and skilling eco-system for maritime sector vis a vis the STCW and the vision to ensure growth of seafarers from the existing 12% to 20% globally.
- (ix) To review action plans and strategies for value added inputs for well being and institutionalization of psychometric screening in the entrance point to a career in the maritime sector.
