

01st STCW Compliance Board Meeting held on 11.01.2024

1	Discuss the matter of Sri Chakra Maritime College, Auroville before for STCW Compliance Board.	<p>1. The STCW Compliance Board draft order has been circulated to all proposed members of the STCW Compliance Board for inputs and views. Based on collection of the inputs thereof there shall be a discussion to finalise the terms of reference and issue of the STCW Compliance Board notification.</p> <p>2. It was clarified by DG (Shipping) that the STCW Compliance Board shall only look at certain specific issues relating to MTI's as a limited and minimal exercise with a larger focus on the STCW Compliance as being finalized. However, there shall be three stages for issues relating to MTI's.</p> <p>STAGE-I: The PO, MMD and surveyor's concerned shall submit the finding and submission as pertaining to the MTI with reference to the DGS Circular and collected documentary material and the recommendation of the PO, MMD shall be recorded.</p> <p>STAGE-II: The STCW Compliance Board shall here the representation from the MTI as coordinated by the Member Secretar5r, DDG (Training) and take the same on record to address the principle of natural justice'</p> <p>STAGE-III: An internal Final discussion shall be held with the final draft order which shall then be recorded by consensus and thereafter the order shall be issued by the DDG (Training).</p> <p>3. It was noticed that RO as surveyors do not have real time data on placement from DGS E-Governance while undertaking CIP and this has to be rectified with a specific observation that the data for placement should be accessed through the Training Division prior to CIP/inspection by RO.</p> <p>4. Separately, since there were issued with the CIP, a in the instant case dnv did the initial CIP for Sri Chakra Maritime college (MTI no. 402017) and graded A1 and subsequently downgraded from A1 B2 for overall grading and C2 for placement record and such change in rating leave scope for legal redresal/complaints/arbitrariness and this needs to be obviated. The DDG Training shall conduct a workshop on CIP with the RO and surveyors and PO, MMD's and deapartmental surveyors to ensure clear comprehension and compliance to DGS Circular</p>
