1	Indian Register of Shippins. Mumbai.	As per discussion, it was decided that the institute may be indicated as "Closed with effect from -----" instead of "Withdrawal of approval of recognition of institute". Further, regarding the qualification of the surveyors, Shri Senthil Kumar informed the issue has already been deliberated with IRS and the proposal has been appreciated by them, thus no action is required presently.
2	Discuss matter to Cosmopolitan Technology of Maritime, Sriperumbadur	During the meeting no comments/inputs were received from any members of the STCW Compliance Board on the draft speaking order and as per discussion it was decided that the draft speaking order circulated is final and may be issued.
3	Complaint against Albert maritime Institute, Kalamassery, Kochi.	(i) The PO, MMD, Kochi and the surveyor who have conducted survey or visit to the MTIs shall make an elaborate PPT presentation with reference to specific DGS circular/guidelines and shall submitted to the STCW compliance board with the specific recommendations of the PO, MMD, Kochi. (ii) The STCW Compliance Board meeting is re-scheduled for 09.02.2024 at 1630 Hrs to discuss the said matter.
4	Circular regarding collection of details of shipboard training by ROs.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. All ROs conducting CIP of any pre-sea MTI shall take the data regarding placement records for on-board training of MTI only from the E-governance system of the Directorate. 2. The ROs shall not finalize the categorization of grading for CIP, the same will be done in consulatation and prior approval of the concerned MMD's. 3. The same shall be incorporated in the draft circular circulated and accordingly revised it and put up with consultation of the members of STCW Compliance Board through email. 4. Before finalizing the said circular, it will be circulated through DGS website for comments/inputs of the stakeholders. 5. Regarding taking the data from the E-governance system and finalizing the categorization of grading for CIP, it shall be communicated separately to the ROs.
