**Subject: Examination for Steam/Motor (Endorsement) / Combined (Steam & Motor), Certificate of Competency.**

Ref .: Section M-III/9 Para 9.4 and 13.4; MS (STCW), Rules 1998 ,META manual Volume 1.

1. A Candidate holding either a "Motor" or "Steam" Certificate of Competency and desiring to appear for Steam/Motor endorsement is required to appear for "Steam/Motor " written and oral examination of the relevant grade.
2. A candidate desiring to appear for a Marine Engineer Officer Class II or Class IV **Combined** Certificate of Competency (Steam & Motor) is required to sit for all functions (six papers) of the relevant grade of examination in Motor and additionally appear for written and oral examination of Steam paper i.e total seven papers.
3. Questions on Steam paper will consist of "Marine Engineering" & " Maintenance and Repairs".
4. Examination shall be held as per the revised Time Table i.e. Revision 1 issue date 9<sup>th</sup> March 06.

This procedure is to be implemented for the candidates appearing from the month of March 06.
