
**Subject: MEO Class IV e-Pariksha Results**

The Directorate has been conducting e-Pariksha for MEO Class IV candidates since June 2013. It has now been decided to modify the process of approval of results of e-Pariksha to enable speedy declaration of e-Pariksha written examination results. Following procedures need to be followed from the month of June 2013, accordingly:-

- 1) M/s IITB will forward results of written examinations of e-Pariksha to the examination centres of MMDs conducting e-Pariksha and Directorate simultaneously within seven days of completion of e-Pariksha for that month.
- 2) Individual MMD's will verify the written examination results and convey any objections, if any, to the Directorate within three working days of receipt of written e-Pariksha results from M/s IITB.
- 3) In case no objections are received from MMD's within three working days of receipt of results from M/s IITB, the Directorate will deem that the said results are approved by the respective MMDs, and declare the written e-Pariksha results on DGS website and through the e-Pariksha module.
- 4) Individual MMDs will compile written & oral results of only those candidates who have secured overall pass in the examination and forward these results to the Directorate for approval of the Chief Examiner of Engineers

This procedure is to be followed only for MEO Class IV e-Pariksha results. Extant procedures for results of other categories remain the same, unless MMDs can suggest a more constructive mechanism in the interest of speed, transparency & overall propriety.

This issues with the approval of Chief Examiner of Engineers.
