Subject: Applicability of Oral Examination pertaining to Marine Engineer Officer Examination.

The Directorate has been receiving a number of representations from the candidates requesting waiver from provisions of Para 9.6 of Section M-III/9 of META Manual Volume I, which stipulates that oral examination pertaining to Marine Engineer Officers examinations, wherever applicable will have to be passed within a period of 18 months from the date of passing of the written examination of relevant function(s).

After due deliberation, it has been decided that the requirements as per the provisions of Para 9.6 of Section M-III/9 of META Manual Volume I are not applicable for any grade of Marine Engineer Officers Examinations from the date of issue of this circular.
