In continuation of the para 7 of the Training Circular No.17 of 2013 dated 12.08.2013 and para 8 of the Training Circular No.19 of 2013 dated 10.9.2013, it is clarified as follows :

2. Institutes while conducting Ship Security Officer's [SSO] course for the admitted candidates, may induct the additional candidates to attend only the 3 hours module for SSO Upgradation to STCW 2010, subject to the following :

- a) The approved capacity for the SSO course per batch shall not be exceeded overall, including these additional candidates for SSO Upgradation to STCW 2010 course.
- b) The approved frequency shall not be exceeded
- c) Such institutes are required to convey their intentions to induct additional candidates to attend the above module, in writing to the D.G. Shipping, alongwith an Undertaking as in (a) & (b) above.

3. Institutes while conducting Medical First Aid course for the admitted candidates, may induct the additional candidates to attend only the 3 hours module for Medical First Aid Refresher Training, subject to the following :

- a) The approved capacity for the MFA course per batch shall not be exceeded overall, including these additional candidates for MFA Refresher course.
- b) The approved frequency shall not be exceeded
- c) Such institutes are required to convey their intentions to induct additional candidates to attend the above module, in writing to the D.G. Shipping, alongwith an Undertaking as in (a) & (b) above.


4. Institutes while conducting Medical Care course for the admitted candidates, may induct the additional candidates to attend only the 3 hours module for Medical First Aid Refresher Training or 6 hours module for Medical Care, subject to the following :

- b) The approved frequency shall not be exceeded
- c) Such institutes are required to convey their intentions to induct additional candidates to attend the above modules, in writing to the D.G. Shipping, alongwith an Undertaking as in (a) & (b) above

5. The institutes are not permitted to conduct SSO Upgradation, MFA Refresher or Medical Care Refresher courses as stand-alone modules.

6. No applications for approval of the said modules on SSO Upgradation, Medical First Aid Refresher Training or Medical Care Refresher Training, as a stand-alone course, shall entertained.
