NT Branch Circular No. NT/ISPS/SHIP/01/2014

Sub: Guidance to vessels for entry into Indian Port Facilities - ISPS compliance related issued.

1. Attention is invited to circular No. NT/ISPS/Ports/13/2005 dated 21st November, 2005, No.NT/ISPS/SHIP/2/ 2009 dated 2nd February, 2009 and addendum dated 20th October, 2011 on the subject of "Guidelines to vessels for entry into Indian Port Facilities-ISPS compliant related issues" wherein ships intending to enter Indian ports were required to provide the information as per Regulation XI-2/9.2 of SOLAS (Control and Compliance Measures - Ships intending to enter a port of another contracting Government).

2. However, several cases have been brought to the notice of this Directorate where vessels have not complied with the aforesaid requirements. Therefore, it is reiterated that the information of Pre Arrival Notification of Security (PANS) may be forwarded, 96 hours in advance, to the concerned agencies mentioned in the above referred circulars, failing which the vessels may be denied entry into the port facilities as per the provisions under the ISPS code.
