



Background: In continuation of N. T. Wing/Exam Circular No.02 of 2013 Dated 01 .11.2013, It has been observed that the candidates are better prepared for the oral exams as it provides sufficient time to candidates for proper preparations which they might have missed or bypassed during written examination/theoretical syllabus preparations.

Decision taken: In view of above, sharing experience of Mumbai MMD and in order to ensure better preparedness, examinees failing in oral examinations will not be allowed to appear at the next oral examination being held in the next consecutive month. This will reduce work load in other MMDs as well, which are presently witnessing scarcity of officers.

This circular will come into effect from 01.04.2014 at all examination centers and is subject to annual review.
