

NT/ENG Circular No. 01 of 2015

1. Reference is invited to the NT/ENG Circular No. 12 of 2012, dated 28.12.2012 and its addendum issued on 16.04.2013, following instructions are to be noted and complied with immediate effect from the date of issue of this circular.
2. The NT/ENG Circular No. 12 of 2012 (Para 5) requires Facilitation Centre (FC) to collect applicable fees by demand draft as per M.S. STCW Rules, 1998 in addition to their nominal service charge and the fees are then submitted to the concerned P.O's every week.
3. Consequent to publication of M.S (STCW) Rules, 2014, it has been observed that the fees earlier collected i.e., Rs.1250/- [ref. item 19 (a), 20] and Rs. 1000/- [ref. item 21] of schedule of fees of Rule 50 of MS (STCW) Rule, 1998 has been increased to Rs. 3750/- [ref. item 31(a)] and Rs. 3000/- [ref. item 32] of rule 78 of MS (STCW) Rule 2014.
4. In order to have uniformity in application with respect to collection of fees among all FC's and in pursuant to the provisions under M.S. (STCW), Rules 2014, all FCs are hereby informed to collect fees of Rs. 3750/- in accordance with the provisions of Rule 78 of MS (STCW) Rule 2014 [ref. item no 31(a), 32] and Rs.3000/- [ref. item 33] of the schedule for issuance of Certificate of Proficiency for Watch Keeping and Tanker Endorsements to ratings, issuance of Certificate of Proficiency for Tanker Endorsement to Petty Officers & to Deck Cadets & Trainee Marine Engineers respectively.

This issues with the approval of the Chief Examiner of Master and Mates and Chief examiner of engineers.
