
Corrigendum to NT/ENG Circular No. 02 of 2014

The second last para of the NT/ENG Circular No.2 of 2014 may be read as :

“While applying for the Certificate of Endorsement, the prospective employer shall submit the following undertaking:

- i) The authenticity of the COC as held by the officer to be employed has been verified from the issuing authority;
- ii) The officer to be employed is appropriately qualified as per the Minimum Safe Manning Document applicable to the vessel; and,
- iii) A declaration from the officer self-certifying his/her unblemished service on vessels of similar type and comparable power has been obtained and retained for records and for scrutiny by the concerned authorities.”

This corrigendum is issued with the approval of the Director General of Shipping.
