Passenger Ship Familiarisation Course
(Crowd Management, Passenger Safety and Safety Training for Personnel providing direct services to Passengers in Passenger Spaces)

This office has issued the Training Circular No.10 of 2004, [File no.11-TR (46)/2003] dated, 22nd March, 2004, spelling out guidelines for the conduct of the Passenger Ship Familiarisation (Crowd Management) course conforming to the STCW-1995 requirements.

2 This office has compared the standards of competence for the 'Crowd Management, Passenger Safety, and Safety Training for Personnel providing direct services to Passengers in Passenger Spaces' under the STCW 1995 (referred to as the Passenger Ship Familiarisation Course in India), with those contained thereto in the STCW 2010, in Regulation V/2 & Section A-V/2, and has then come to the conclusion that there is no substantial difference between the STCW-1995 and STCW 2010 regulations. This office has, therefore, decided that there will be no need for any Refresher and Updating training for this course and that the Certificates issued under the STCW 95 by the D G Shipping approved Maritime Training Institutes shall continue to remain valid even after 01.01.2017, provided that the seafarer concerned has done 12 months of sea service on-board passenger ships within the last five years.

3 A revised format of the said Course Certificate is enclosed [Annexure-I: 1+page] to ensure clarity and consistency, which the Maritime Training Institutes approved by this office for this course are required to comply with for such training completed after 15.08.16.
