D.G. Shipping Circular 07 of 2021

Subject: - Review of debarment of Continuous Discharge Certificates (CDC) - reg.

Whereas The Directorate had issued DGS Circular No. 34 of 2020 (F.No.23-65011(11)/2/2020-CREW-DGS dated 12.11.2020 reducing the debarment period for applying to Government shipping Offices at Mumbai, Chennai & Kolkata for fresh Continuous Discharge Certificates (CDCs) under the Merchant Shipping [Continuous Discharge Certificates] Rules, 2017.

2. In Para 7 of the said circular instead of the words **“debarment of 3 years from the date of its issue “may be read as” from the date of receipt of such fake application from the concerned candidate”**.

1. All other terms and conditions of the said Circular remain unchanged.
